Two males arrested for aggravated robbery at Magill

Eastern Adelaide Police have arrested two males following an incident at Alton Avenue, Magill overnight. At about 2.40am police responded to reports that a taxi driver had been assaulted and robbed by a number of males. Police attended and searched the area. They located and arrested the two after a short foot chase. A 19 year old man from Parafield Gardens and a 17 year old male youth from Maylands have been charged with numerous offences including aggravated robbery and aggravated assault. Both were refused bail. The 19 year old is expected to appear in the Adelaide Magistrates Court and the 17 year old is expected to appear in the Adelaide Youth Court today. Several other suspects, described as being of dark complexion, managed to flee the scene. Three men arrested for trafficking drugs

Elizabeth Police arrested three men at a mechanical workshop at Greenfields yesterday and charged them with trafficking a controlled drug.
